The primary disco will be on Tuesday 15th December from 5.30-8.30pm. It will be open to year 3-6. Clubs – Please be aware that we will be invoicing for clubs and fun club in January as pupils are listed now. If you wish to cancel or join a club for January term please e mail now to request changes. Any changes after invoices are issued will not be refunded, including cancelling a club part way through the term. **Chess club with Mr Jones and Netball will not run from January.** Clubs are charged: half hour lunchtime clubs 30e per term, one hour clubs 60 e p/t, hour and a half 90 e p/t.
