Gym and Swimming – Sports lessons have now started in primary classes. Your child should know when they have either gym or swimming. Please ensure they bring in their kit on the correct day.

Bus Lane – Please be aware that some days we have up to 14 buses arriving at school during the day. Please DO NOT park in the mid section of the designated bus lane, at anytime other than first thing in the morning after our 2 morning buses have been and gone. Mr Baumann is on duty at this time and will indicate where parking is permitted.

This area must be kept clear for the rest of the day to allow our gym and swimming buses in and out.
