# St George's Secondary School Curriculum

## Overview

St George's International School, Luxembourg is a caring and supportive learning environment with high expectations of all students. The Secondary school has 280 students, small enough to be able to focus on the individual needs of the student, but large enough to offer a broad and balanced academic curriculum.

## Curriculum

St George's International School is proud to offer the **National Curriculum for England and Wales**. This curriculum prepares our students for their role in an increasingly challenging and rapidly changing world. Students learn in a stimulating, caring and supportive environment where academic excellence is balanced with opportunities for personal development. The National Curriculum leads to **IGCSE** (International General Certificate of Secondary Education) examinations which are taken at the age of 16 and then later **A Level** examinations taken at the age of 18, qualifications recognised and highly valued by universities worldwide.



## Key Stage 3: Years 7, 8 & 9 (age 11-14)

The curriculum in Key Stage 3 is subject based and develops the ability of individual students to work independently and think critically. At this stage the emphasis is on exposing students to a wide range of subjects so that they can begin to form an idea of where their academic interests may lie.

### All students study the following subjects:

- Mathematics, Science, English
- Modern Foreign Languages (French and German)
- The Arts (Music, Drama, Art)
- Humanities (History, Geography)
- Physical Education
- SMSC (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural Education)
- ICT

## Key Stage 4: Years 10 & 11 (age 14-16)

In Key Stage 4 we offer students a balanced curriculum of IGCSEs. It is compulsory for students to study English Language & Literature, Mathematics, Coordinated Sciences (which count as 2 IGCSEs and incorporate Biology, Chemistry & Physics), and a Modern Foreign Language (French or German). Students then choose four further subjects from a list of options. The options may change from year to year, depending on the needs of each cohort. All students also take Physical Education and Spiritual, Moral, Social & Cultural Education (SMSC) which are not examined.

Additional subjects offered at Key Stage 4 are: Media Studies, Psychology, Computer Science, Business Studies, Geography, Art, Craft & Design, Drama, GCSE Physical Education, Music, History, Study Skills, German and Economics.

## Key Stage 5 (Sixth Form): Years 12 & 13 (age 17-18)

Key Stage 5 (also known as Sixth Form) offers students a range of international **A** (Advanced) **Level** courses from a variety of UK exam boards (**Edexcel and CIE - Cambridge International Examinations**). The A Level course focuses on traditional study skills and take a minimum of 2 years to complete. They are very demanding and academically rigorous however, once the examinations are passed students can apply to universities worldwide.
